Common User Berth Bunkering and Work Permit process

This process is to be followed for the bunkering of vessels by road tanker and other operational tasks performed on vessels that are berthed at common user berths in Port Kembla. The process is for all non-cargo related activities on Port Kembla common user berths (B104, B201, B206). The activities are:

- Any activity that requires a permit from the Port Authority of NSW to carry out work on a vessel or confined space entries etc
- Bunkering of vessels by barge or road tanker
- Access to the berth by heavy trucks or machinery.

Shipping agents or Terminal operators are to send a request for pre-approval for all work permits, bunkers by barge/road tanker, heavy vehicle access on any of the above common user berths. Please email or contact one of the Port Operations Team
