Local Area Traffic – General Update Swift Transport requested a review of the 6 tonne left turn limit into the complex from Cosgrove Rd (Punchbowl Rd end). - Drivers are continuing down Cosgrove Rd and doing a u-turn at the roundabout to enter the complex via Cosgrove Rd - The 6 tonne limit sign was applicable when boom gates were active at the entrance to prevent traffic issues on Cosgrove Rd however the boom gates are no longer in use - NSW Ports to review Wentworth Street issues, raised in previous meetings, is an ongoing issue:	NSWP (MB)

	 Corner of Norfolk Road and Wentworth Street – cars parked close to this corner make it tight for 2 B-Doubles to pass. The corner is also close to the busy Boral concrete batching plant entrance. Trucks parking at the café north of the Enfield ILC entrance sometimes restrict / encroach on the main south bound traffic lane 	
	Bingo Bins has trucks queueing on both sides of the street just south of the Enfield ILC entrance	
	Strathfield Council advised the upgrade of Wentworth Street road surface repairs is now complete. Strathfield Council advised that a DA application for the reconfiguration of the corner should be put to council. NSW Ports will review and consider its position.	NSWP (MB)
	Continued issues with non-ILC complex users utilising Mainline Rd as a shortcut between Wentworth Ave and Cosgrove Rd. NSW Ports advised that traffic management plans are continually under review. This issue will continue to be monitored.	NSWP (MB)
3.	Project Construction Update Goodman has been appointed by NSW Ports to manage the development of Enfield ILC. Tenants have been secured and construction of Precinct E & F is underway.	Note
	Swift Transport requested better communications for onsite tenants on construction. Signs for Precinct E in relation to Asbestos Removal where placed on the site with no communication with existing tenants. As a result they were uncertain if there was any safety issue in regards to the removal of any contaminated fill.	
	LINX advised that there are issues with dirt and mud tracking into the LINX Terminal and requested that the sweepers/water trucks ensure the LINX and Swift entrances remain clean also. Additionally, drivers of the vehicles are using Swift driveway as a turning point.

	Intermodal Terminal (LINX)	Note
	LINX reported that they are now currently utilising 98% of their footprint and expect throughput volumes in excess of 50,000 teu within the year. The service loads to and from port are now well balanced and LINX have been holding back importers due to lack of port windows. ACFS Empty Park has commenced moving in and it is expected that de-hiring will commence within the next two weeks. LINX and ACFS are working together to provide de-hire services to parties that are	
	utilising rail services.
