

Position Vacant - Property Strategy Manager

The role of Property Strategy Manager is accountable for the overall strategic and operational management of the property portfolio and team for NSW Ports in relation to its land holdings and will be involved in new business commercial negotiations.

Key accountabilities for the role will include:

- Develop the NSW Ports property strategy and implement the property portfolio strategic and operational
 plans including land use planning, strategic land acquisition, lease performance metrics and site utilisation to
 facilitate trade growth, drive performance outcomes, maximise investment returns and enhance site
 utilisation.
- Establish strategic goals by gathering pertinent business, financial, service, and operations information; identifying and evaluating trends and options; choosing a course of action; defining objectives; evaluating outcomes.
- Optimise the property portfolio by increasing revenue from commercial activities to support NSW Ports in achieving its strategic, financial, and sustainability objectives in conjunction with the Commercial and Business Development team.
- Be actively involved in and manage complex and/or commercially significant lease negotiations.
- Prepare feasibility studies for potential tenants, assessing the suitability of the site for the proposed end use.
- Prepare Board papers and/or stakeholder presentations as required.
- Drive engagement with tenants and the broader commercial property industry with the objective of achieving increased understanding of the value of the port.
- Oversee the preparation of budgets, stakeholder reporting, reviews and compliance.
- Management of the Property team and collaborating with team in procuring appropriate tenants, reviewing
 tenancy applications and negotiating lease terms and conditions in line with best commercial practices this
 also includes the management of expressions of interest and tenders for new tenants. Also manage the
 process for the execution of leases, licences and associated contracts including the registration of leases with
 the LPI.
