- Total import volume is up 13.7% or 183,000RT, This increase is due predominantly to steel raw materials which is up over 259kRT compared to last year, such as manganese and iron ore. Last month this commodity was down 155kRT, there was an additional two vessels for this commodity this month to last.
- Motor vehicle imports were down marginally by 1kRT
- Cement clinker was also down 86kRT to the same period last year.
- Exports
- Total export volume is down 321,000 RT or 27.9% ,This decrease is generally with coal and coke which is down 449,000 RT or just over 58%.
- Grain is up 166,000RT compared to last year or a 55% increase on last year.
- Copper concentrates are down along with steel finished products
- Overall Port Kembla has 77 vessel visits which is down 8% on the same period last year.
