- Imports
  - Total import volume is up 40% or 397,000 RT compared with the same period last year.
  - This increase is due an increase in motor vehicle imports which is up 19% or 83,000RT.
  - Steel materials which is predominantly waste steel is up 142,000 RT or 40% to last year.
  - Cement clinker was also up 18,000 RT compared to last year.
- Exports
  - Total export volume is down 196,000 RT or 20.8% This decrease is generally with coal and coke which is down 373,000 RT or just over 68%. There was an outbound shut down for 3 days at the start of May.
  - Grain is up 457,000RT compared to last year which had only 50kRT last year,.
  - Copper concentrates are also down 11,000RT which is down due to an earthquake in the central west which has had an impact on production.
  - Steel and finished products is also down with reduced production..
