

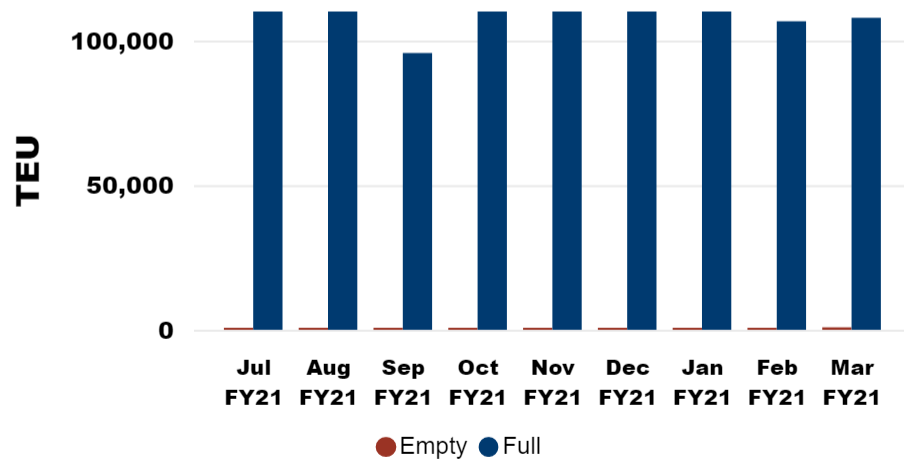

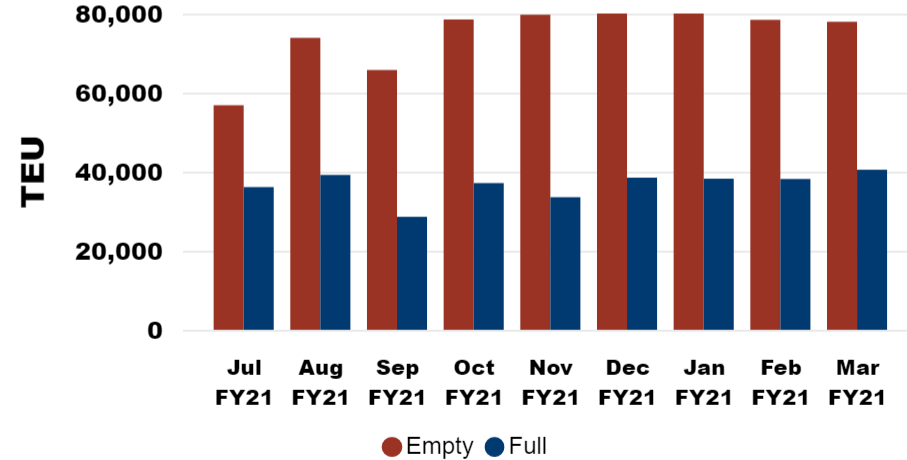

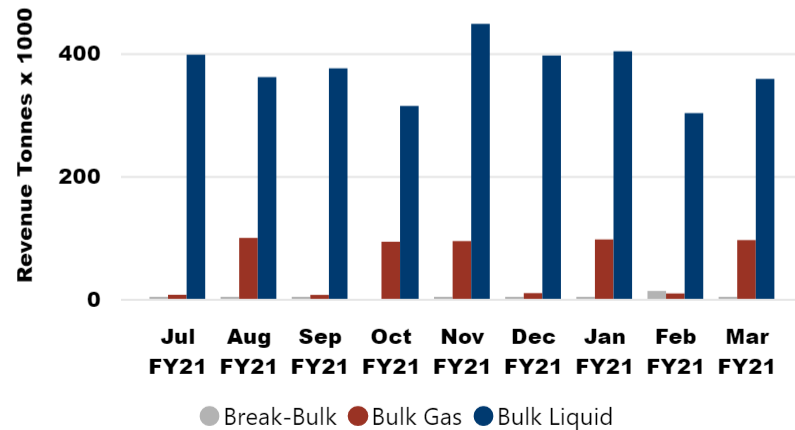

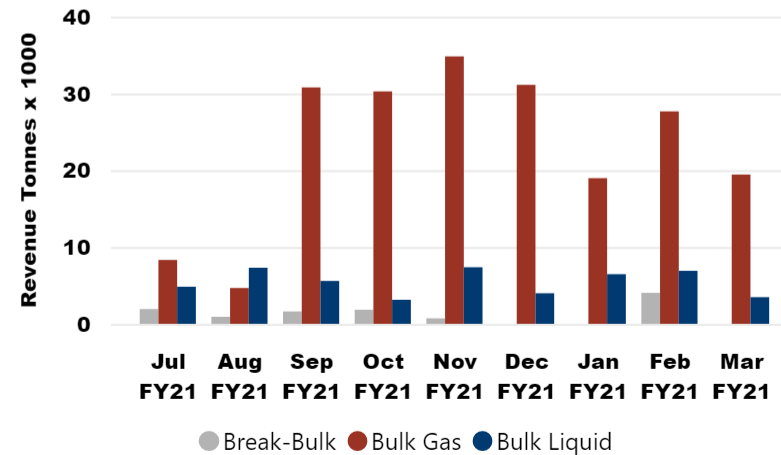

Port Botany YTD Non-Containerised Imports by Cargo Class in Revenue Tonnes for FY21



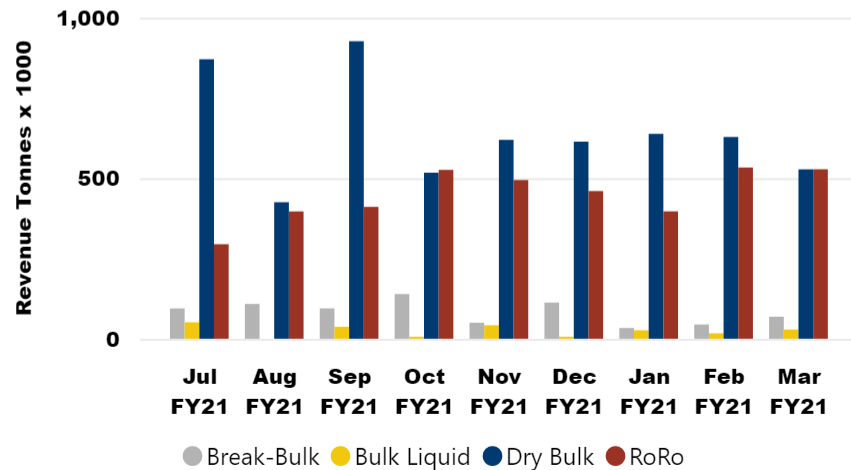
Port Botany YTD Non-Containerised Exports by Cargo Class in Revenue Tonnes for FY21



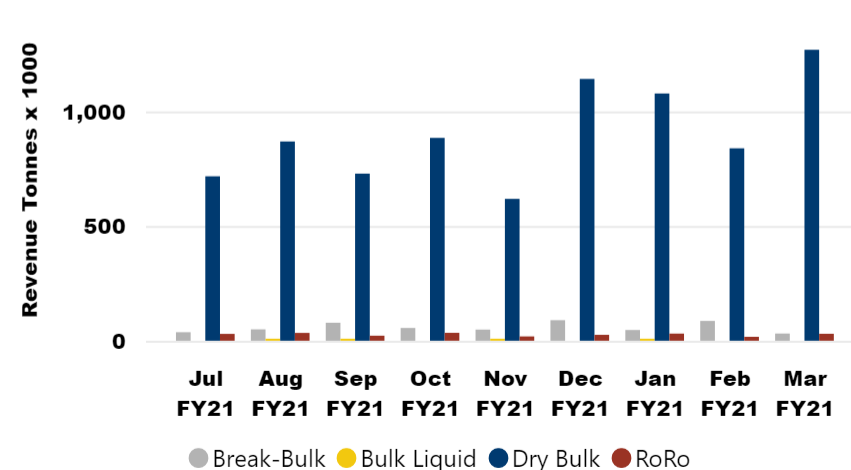

Port Kembla YTD Non-Containerised Imports by Cargo Class in Revenue Tonnes for FY21



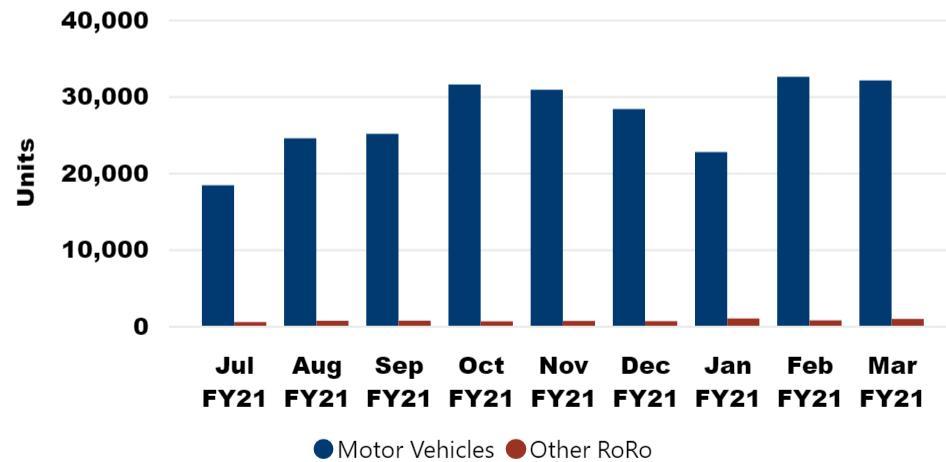
Port Kembla YTD Non-Containerised Exports by Cargo Class in Revenue Tonnes for FY21



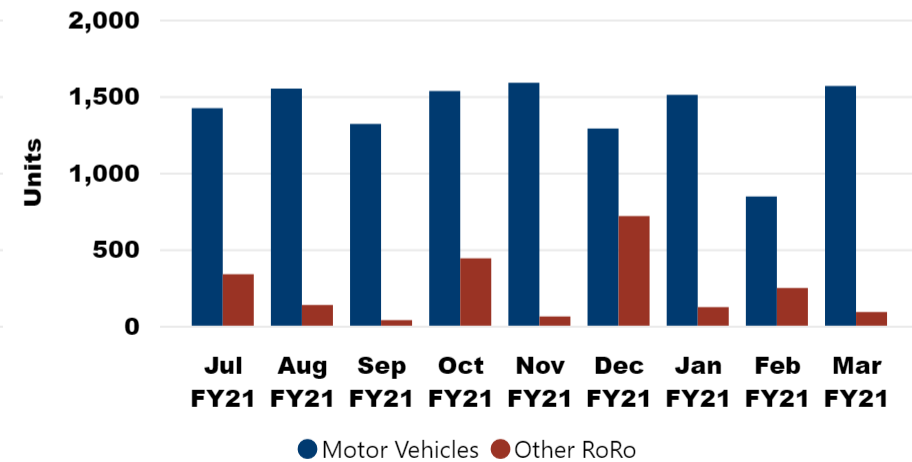

Revenue Tonne - the greater of mass or volume of the cargo measured in units of metric tonnes, cubic metres, or kilolitres.
