1. Precinct Update

1.1. Traffic Incidents (PU)

Burnouts

Burnout incidents have been prominent within the period of December 2024 to April 2024. Three key instances were observed in February and March, whereby perpetrators undertook burnouts, and were seen speeding down Mainline Rd whilst driving on the wrong side of the road.


Each of these instances were reported to Auburn Police and NSW Ports are awaiting update on outcomes.

Vehicles parking in the C1 carpark

Recent increase in non-Northside Fine Food vehicles illegally parking on the C1 driveway and carpark along Cosgrove Rd, typically outside of business hours (Mon-Fri after 6pm, and Weekends). NSW Ports seeking assistance from Council and Police to issue notices, in alignment with the Port operator Directions (as per the PAMA Act 1995).

Action: (JI) to follow-up council parking rangers for assistance in issuing notices to vehicles illegally parked on the C1.2 driveway.

1.3. Road Maintenance Updates (MG)

In May of 2025, NSW Ports are planning to install 2x continuous heavy duty rubber speed cushions (2m wide x 75mm height) as shown below. Works will also include the removal of existing lane separators and re-lining or road markings as per below.

Traffic Control will be present, and works will only be undertaken on the weekend.

The updated OTMP was approved by the Department of Planning, and a key change to the document is the inclusion of the Traffic and Capacity Monitoring Program (Section 14 of the OTMP). The TCMP has been updated to include the obligation to complete a 'Traffic Route Survey' in accordance with the Enfield ILC project approval (condition 3.6) using the newly developed truck route survey form.
